Executive Director of the Chanticleer Athletic Foundation (CAF) Chris Johnson reported that Coach Chadwell had attended 11 community events and been well received. He will be coming to a future Board of Trustees meeting.

Kelly Moore and Michael Jacobs did a phenomenal job with the Chanticleer Gala. Six hundred people attended, and there were 200 auction items. This year \$121,000 was raised; last year \$104,000 was raised.

There are four new members of the CAF board. The annual meeting will be held on May 14 in the Alford Ballroom.

Director of Athletics Matt Hogue said the Brooks Stadium project will be completed by mid to late June.

Baseball had a 10-12% increase in season tickets.

This spring Coastal Carolina University received the Excellence in Management Cup which recognizes the Division 1 FBS athletic program who maximized their spending in relation to winning both conference and national titles and includes all schools in the country. It is developed and awarded by College Sports Lab at Texas A&MS' Sports Management Graduate Program. Coastal Carolina was number one in the list of the Top 25 National Rankings Rank.

Madeline Bromley was named the ASUN (Atlantic Sun Conference) Lacrosse Scholar Athlete of the Year.

Amadou Bamba, men's basketball, was named CoSida (College Sports Information Directors of America) Academic All American.

All CCU sports are well above the 950 required Academic Progress Rate (APR) numbers. Women's Beach Volley Ball and Women's Tennis had 1000 APR numbers.

Spring sports successes include Men's Golf winning Furman Intercollegiate Golf Tournament; second place finish SBC Championships stroke play; Zach Taylor selected for individual participation in NCAA Men's Golf Regional at Tournaments Play Club (TPC) Myrtle Beach hosted by Coastal Carolina; and, Women's Golf tied for first place at Edwin Watts Kiawah Island Classic. Other sports are ongoing.
